- Linoleum – There are no limits to colors or textures with rubber. Additional differences include superior acoustics and underfoot comfort.
- Carpet - Incredible stain resistance and ease of maintenance sets cork rubber apart. With Sustain, there is no place for dirt and grit to hide resulting in cleaner floors and air.
- Recycled Rubber – Sustain Cork Rubber has no unpleasant odor and is non-porous. It doesn't require a topical finish and won't break down from sweat and other contaminants common in a workout environment.

General Installation:

Concrete & Plywood: Install Sustain over smooth sub-floor using one of three adhesives depending upon traffic and load conditions.

Access Flooring: Contact Zandur for application specific instructions.

Maintenance: After initial maintenance cleaning, floor may be left uncoated or may be coated with an acrylic or urethane finish. Damp mop with neutral cleaner on regular basis. Floor may be scrubbed as desired.

Beneficial Properties in Detail:

Slip Resistant – Sustain has the highest slip resistance available in rubber flooring. Materials exceed applicable standards and recommendations to reduce the possibility of slip & fall claims. In the event a fall does occur, the product's resilience can help to limit injuries.

Low Reflectivity - The texture of the product reduces glare and reflection which is particularly important for assisted living applications.

Durable – Products are manufactured so that patterns and colors run through entire thickness. Even after years of use, it will maintain its pattern, color and beauty. Zandur products are warranted for 10 years against complete wear through.

Acoustically Beneficial – The cork component significantly enhances acoustical benefits reducing sound levels from foot traffic. Its acoustic properties are superior to other resilient flooring including vinyl, solid rubber and linoleum.

Comfortable – Sustain is composed of 65% cork which ensures that the flooring is comfortable and resilient under foot and feels warm to the touch. Particularly beneficial in applications where users are on their feet for extended periods of time as it effectively reduces fatigue.

Easy To Maintain –Routine maintenance involves damp mopping or using an auto-scrubber in combination with a suitable cleaning solution. Finishes are typically not required. Most resilient flooring maintenance regimes are compatible with Zandur Rubber based products.

Low life cycle cost – During the life of the product, the annual cost is less than other materials such as vinyl and carpeting due to reasonable product cost, low maintenance costs and high durability.

Safe: Sustain Cork rubber meets all US and International standards for Fire, Smoke and Slip Resistance. Additionally, it is comfortable underfoot and anti-microbial. Like all Zandur rubber products, Sustain is Red-List Chemical Free.
