

Life Cycle Study

Rubber and Cork Rubber Flooring

Below are two studies looking at common floor covering products taking into consideration the initial cost of material and, more importantly, the maintenance costs. Although the initial cost of rubber is higher than many alternatives, lifetime cost is far below the average in terms of both material cost (per year) as well as maintenance. This analysis pertains to all Zandur rubber-based flooring products including Sustain and Flex. Rubber flooring has no equal in terms of low life cycle cost, safety, and sustainability.
